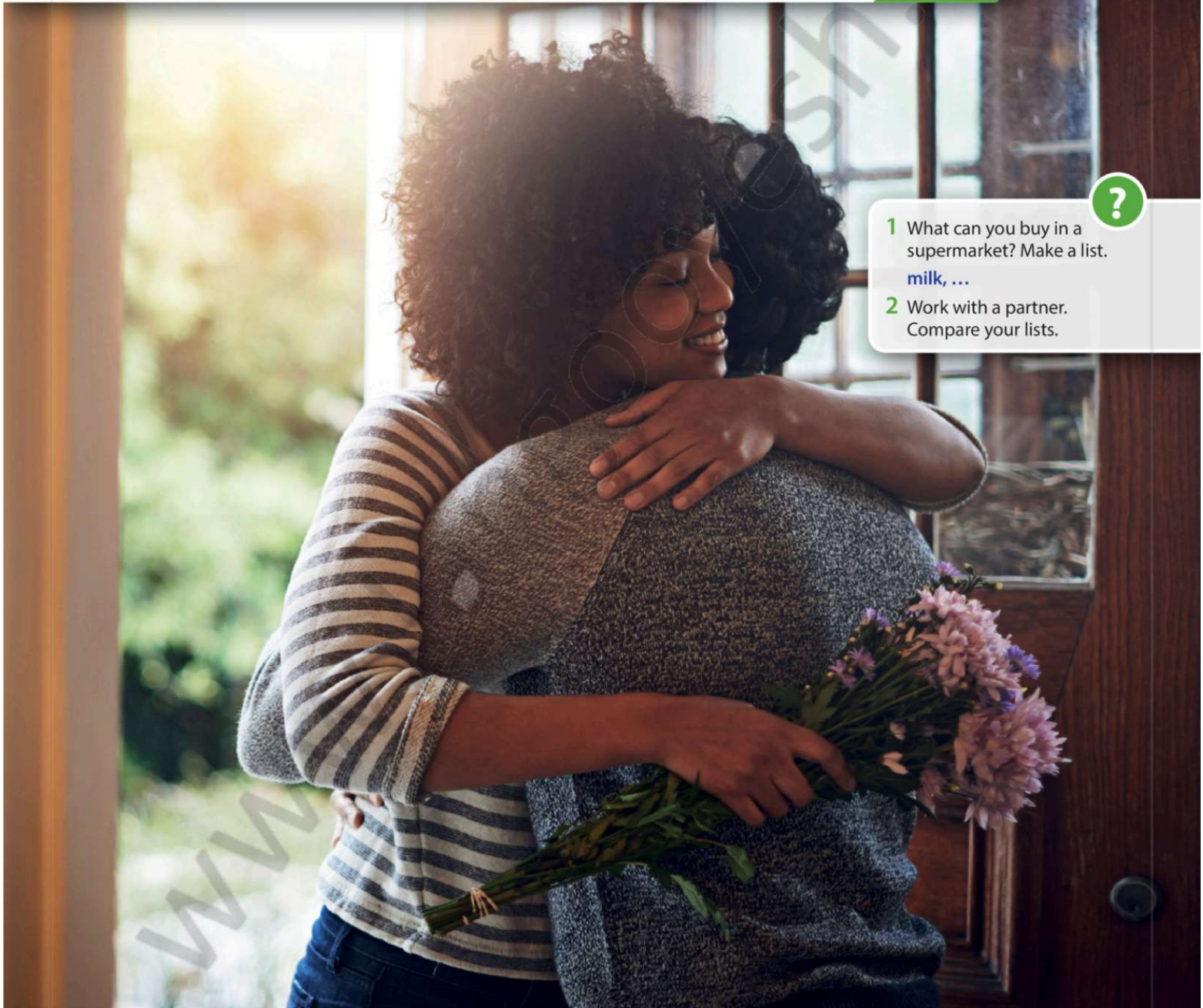

- I'd like* ... is more polite than *I want* ...
I'd like some ham, please.
- We offer things with *Would you like ...?* and *Would you like to...?*
Would you like anything else?
Would you like to watch a film?

some and any

- We use *some* in positive sentences.
I'd like *some* apples.
- We use *any* with questions and negatives.
Do you have *any* oranges?
We don't have *any* oranges.
We can also use *some* when we offer things.
Would you like *some* coffee?
