The female staff in the hotel reception area wear blue and white dresses that look like the Chinese vases. The waitresses in the hotel bar have black and gold dresses that look like the Chinese paintings. The beautiful uniforms are not for special occasions – the hotel employees wear them every day. In hotels, it is very important that the staff is always comfortable. Each worker is given three uniforms, but they can choose their own shoes.
